Row 1, Section 1

Psalm 119:11

**<sup>11</sup> Your word I have treasured in my heart,  
That I may not sin against You.**

John 14:26

**<sup>26</sup> But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My  
name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all  
that I said to you.**

Psalm 119:105

**<sup>105</sup> Your word is a lamp to my feet  
And a light to my path.**

**<sup>38</sup> This is the great and foremost commandment.**

**<sup>39</sup> The second is like it, ‘YOU SHALL LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR AS YOURSELF.’**

**<sup>40</sup> On these two commandments depend the whole Law and the Prophets.”**

Nor sit in the seat of scoffers!**

**2 But his delight is in the law of the LORD,  
And in His law he meditates day and night.**

**3 He will be like a tree *firmly* planted by streams of water,  
Which yields its fruit in its season  
And its leaf does not wither;  
And in whatever he does, he prospers.**

**4 The wicked are not so,  
But they are like chaff which the wind drives away.**

**5 Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment,  
Nor sinners in the assembly of the righteous.**

But the way of the wicked will perish.**
